SHEFFIELD INTERNATIONAL ARTIST'S BOOK PRIZE

The Sheffield International Artist's Book Prize and Exhibition is open to books by artists/makers living and working anywhere in the world.

SIABP is a biennial event attracting entries from across the book arts spectrum. In 2011, over 180 entries were received from 22 different countries. All books submitted will be shown in the exhibition to accompany the Prize running from October 5th to November 30th and will feature in a print catalogue.

The winner of the Exhibition Prize is decided by visitors to the exhibition. Jury and Student Prizes are also awarded. In 2013 there will be a minimum of 4 Prizes and winners will each receive cash, an offer of an exhibition in 2014 and help with the costs of staging that exhibition. This year's judges include Elizabeth James from the National Art Library Collections at the V&A Museum, Alison Gibbons from De Montfort University and Christian Lloyd from The Open College of the Arts.
